



PASHIZ COINS LTD
AUCTION CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement ("Auction Consignment Agreement") is entered into between Pashiz Coins Ltd, hereinafter referred to as the "Auctioneer," and the individual or entity consigning items for auction, hereinafter referred to as the "Consignor."

1. Consignment Services

1.1 Auction Services: The Auctioneer will facilitate the consignment of items for auction and subsequent sale to the highest bidder.

1.2 Auction Fee: The Consignor agrees to pay an auction fee equal to 10% of the hammer price for each item, unless the hammer price is equal to or above 500 GBP, in which case the auction fee is waived.

1.3 Payment to Consignor: The Consignor will receive their payment for items sold at auction within 15 working days after the auction's conclusion.

2. Payment Methods

2.1 Payment Methods: The Consignor can choose one of the following payment methods: bank transfer, cryptocurrency, PayPal, or Western Union. The Consignor is responsible for all payment fees associated with the chosen method.

3. Reporting and Accountability

3.1 Item Records: The Auctioneer will maintain accurate records of all items consigned, including their descriptions, estimated values, hammer prices, and final sale prices.

3.2 Accounting: The Consignor has the right to request a detailed accounting of all transactions related to their consigned items at any time.



4. Unsold Items

4.1 Reconciliation of Unsold Items: In the event an item remains unsold after the auction, the Auctioneer will notify the Consignor and discuss options for reconsignment, return, or alternative disposition.

5. Liability and Indemnification

5.1 Auctioneer's Responsibility: The Auctioneer will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the safe handling of consigned items.

5.2 Item Description: The Consignor will provide a detailed description of each item being consigned, including but not limited to type, denomination, year, and condition.

3.4 Shipping and Insurance: The Consignor is responsible for shipping the items to the Auctioneer, and the Consignor is encouraged to insure the items during transit.

6. Termination

This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon written notice. In the event of termination, the Consignor shall remain responsible for any fees incurred up to the date of termination.

6. Governing Law

This Agreement is governed by the laws of United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. Any disputes arising under or in connection with this Agreement shall be resolved through arbitration or mediation, as mutually agreed upon by both parties.

7. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes any prior or contemporaneous agreements, whether written or oral.
